PACIFIC TENNIS CENTRE IN BURNABY



Tennis Canada is investing in growing the sport of tennis in British Columbia through supporting athletes at all levels, developing much-needed sports infrastructure, and delivering competitive opportunities, including attracting world-class events like the Odlum Brown VanOpen. And a key part of this strategy is to build a new state-of-the-art facility: the Pacific Tennis Centre (PTC).

British Columbia has boasted the highest rates of participation in tennis across the country for a long time. However, the province faces a severe lack of infrastructure preventing players from participating in tennis year-round at an affordable cost.

municipalities While reporting waitlists for use of their covered facilities, there is not a publicly accessible, affordable. all-weather facility in BC that is focused on delivering a full spectrum of community racquet sports programming; including programming for competitive wheelchair and junior tennis athletes.

The PTC will meet this need in BC

The PTC is a proposed tennis and

racquet sports facility that will be Tennis Canada's flagship centre in Western Canada, delivered in partnership with Tennis BC and the City of Burnaby.

The facility will be a world-class, community-serving tennis centre that is inclusive and accessible, helping grow tennis as a sport and meeting the needs of a healthy, active British Columbia and Western Canada. Located in Burnaby, the PTC will also serve as the new home for the National Junior Training Program, and the first and only home for the National Wheelchair Tennis Program, with over 80% of the court time available for affordable, yearround use for the community. The PTC will become a provincial hub

that will deliver inclusive programs for all members of the community, regardless of their income, and support other racquet sports, like pickleball and badminton, across BC and Western Canada.

Once fully completed, the PTC will feature 12 covered courts, up to 14 outdoor courts, including hard and clay, as well as dedicated pickleball courts.

When the federal and provincial government confirm funding for Phases I and II, courts could be open to the public in just over a year with the proper financial backing.









CARLOTA LEE **OUR SUPERWOMAN!**





Anyone who knows Odlum Brown VanOpen chair Carlota Lee knows she is busy. However, since the last tournament three years ago, she's taken it to another level and helped thousands of people along the way, all as we navigated a global pandemic.



In July 2019, Carlota was diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease and immediately became an advocate for those battling the disorder. She joined PD Avengers, a worldwide group of people with Parkinson's, along with their families and friends, all standing together to change how Parkinson's is seen and treated.

Carlota also helped raise \$425.000 for the Pacific Parkinson's Research Institute at UBC, her alma mater, through their Porridge for Parkinson's breakfast fundraiser. From that fundraiser, she connected HealthTech Connex, a medical technology company, with the Pacific Parkinson's Research Institute to fund around \$300,000 for an important study on brain stimulation technology taking place right now.

On top of the incredible amount of money and awareness raised, Carlota is currently helping put together a Women for Parkinson's Committee for Parkinson Canada and will oversee the BC Chapter.

Additionally, she and her husband Derek co-chaired a capital campaign to raise \$5.5 million for Capilano University's Centre for Childhood Studies. Earlier this spring, Carlota received an honorary Doctor of Letters, honoris causa from Capilano University, the highest form of recognition the university grants.

Despite the disease having progressed since her diagnosis, Carlota continues to fight Parkinson's and is determined to prove her neurologist wrong. She always keeps up with Parkinson's research and continues to advocate for and help with Parkinson Canada and the Pacific Parkinson's Research Institute.

Although she can't play tennis anymore and taking care of herself is almost a full-time job, Carlota's positive attitude and energy remain infectious. She maintains a passion for friends and family, and for running Western Canada's largest tennis tournament: the Odlum Brown VanOpen.

GAME, SET, FACT

The origins of tennis can be traced back to a 12th–13th century French handball agame.

The very first tennis balls date back to the 15th century and were made of a variety of materials, mostly leather stuffed with human and horsehair or wool. Scottish craftsmen used the stomach of a sheep or goat wrapped with wool and tied with rope. In the 18th century, strips of wool were tightly wound around a nucleus made of cork. Tennis balls with cork cores and cloth covering are still used in the original game of tennis, known as Real Tennis.

In 1874, Londoner Major Walter C. Wingfeild patented equipment and rules for a game fairly similar to modern-day tennis. Wingfeild's original court was in the shape of an hourglass, narrowing at the net, and it was shorter than the standards for today's courts.

Scotland's King James I. enjoyed playing tennis but kept losing tennis balls in the sewage drain at the corner of the court at the Blackfriars Monastery, so he ordered it sealed. A short time later, assassins would break in and King James would find himself stuck, helplessly restrained behind the newly installed grate. He was subsequently caught and murdered.

The term "love" used in the scoring system of tennis is said to have originated from the French word for egg "l'oeuf," because a zero on a scoreboard resembles an egg. However, the true origin is unknown.



Between the 15th century and 1965 all tennis racquets were made from wood. They were commonly stringed with cow intestines that had been twisted and stretched to create a high-tension elastic surface on the head of the racquet.

Wimbledon once used white tennis balls. But they were replaced with yellow balls in 1986 to make them more visible to TV cameras.

The tiebreak was invented by James Van Alen in 1965. There were originally two types: sudden death which would end after a maximum of 9 points were played, and lingering death, which saw the winner as the first to reach at least 7 points and win with a margin of at least 2 points.

The Real Hawkeye Rufus, a Harris Hawk, is stationed at Wimbledon to keep its sky clear of local pigeons.

Strangely enough, no one quite seems to know why the carving of a pineapple crowns Wimbledon's 18.5 inch high men's singles trophy. One theory suggests it is because British Navy captains put pineapples atop their gateposts upon their return home from sea.



The longest match by far for Professional Tennis was the 2010 Wimbledon first round match-up between John Isner and Nicolas Mahut — Isner eventually beat Mahut 6-4, 3-6, 6-7(7), 7-6(3). 70-68. The match took 11 hours and 5 minutes spanning over three days and playing 183 games.

The longest recorded point took 29 minutes and crossed the net 643 times. This epic rally took place in a women's single match between Vicki Nelson and Jean Hepner on September 24, 1984, at a Virginia Slims tournament in Richmond, VA, USA.

In the 1987 U.S Open, tennis star Chris Evert asked the officials to stop the game because her diamond bracelet had come unclasped and fallen on the court. She asked for time to search for and retrieve her bracelet. Since that time, the bracelet has been referred to as a "tennis bracelet."



Tennis first reached the Olympics in 1896.

It's believed that the word tennis is derived from an earlier version of the game played by monks in the 12th century. Their version of the game involved throwing and catching a ball while shouting 'tenez,' which means to take heed.

A player is said to have won a Career **Grand Slam** if they win all four majors at any time during their career; a Non Calendar-Year Grand Slam if they win the four majors consecutively, but not in the same year, and a Grand Slam if they win all four majors in a single year.



The loudest grunt, which reached 105 decibels, came from Maria Sharapova in 2009 during Wimbledon.

John Isner holds the ATP's official record for the fastest serve at 253 km/h, however the fastest serve ever recorded is an astonishing 263 km/h in 2021 by Sam Groth. It isn't recognized by the ATP as it came at a Challenger event, and they do not formally recognize speeds set at that level. Sam Groth was set to play in the 2017 VanOpen, but had to withdraw due to an unexpected neck injury. Georgina Garcia holds the title for the women's fastest serve at 220 km/h.

The fuzzy covering on a tennis ball is known as The Nap. The felt nylon or fuzziness on the ball is a drag force on the court. The reason for it is to slow down the ball.



The Arthur Ashe Stadium in New York City is the biggest tennis-only venue in the world with a capacity of 23.771. It is named after tennis great Arthur Ashe who won three grand slam titles.


The youngest player to ever win at Wimbledon was Martina Hingis (SWE) when she was partnered with Helena Sukova in 1996 when the pair took the doubles title. She was only 15!

Daniel Nestor and Sebastien Lareau were Canada's first Canadians to ever win a medal in tennis at the Olympics. The team paired up in Sydney in 2000 to beat Australia's Todd Woodbridge and Mark Woodforde in a thrilling two and a half hour match.



There are three main types of tennis courts: grass courts, hard courts and clay courts. Wimbledon is played on grass courts, the French Open is played on clay courts, and the U.S. Open and the Australian Open both use hard courts.


